Advocacy


Partner with like organizations in an effort to advocate for people who have ALS and their families.

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Our fundraising journey actually started with our annual ALS Fishing Tournament. Back in 1995, the tournament was started by family and friends of Kevin Kolquist. Kevin had been diagnosed with ALS and they wanted to do something to make a difference. And is now known as the Kolar Toyota Fishing Tournament.

Shortly after, four riders started the idea of an annual fundraising snowmobile ride when they rode their sleds around Lake Superior in 1999. The group received \$15,000 in contributions, which were used to help those fighting Lou Gehrig's Disease (Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis). This event is now known as the Black Woods Blizzard Tour.

To date, Never Surrender Inc. has raised over: \$22,000,000
