



Wisconsin Blizzard Tour Ride Rules & Etiquette

1. Arrive at the Tour with a full tank of gas and your sled ready to ride. **There will NOT be time to fuel in the morning.**
2. Stay with your group at all times during the ride.
3. If you catch up to a slower or stopped group, please pass with extreme caution! When stopped, stay to the far right of the trail.
4. Practice **'ZERO TOLERANCE'** – **NO alcohol use before or during** the ride.
5. Obey the maximum speed limit at all times.
6. Understand and obey ALL Wisconsin rules and regulations.
7. Know and use international hand signals. (See sheet enclosed)
8. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE RIDER BEHIND YOU.** If you see they are not there, pull over to the right side of the trail and wait.
9. Wait for your group at **all** intersections.
10. **No loud exhaust systems.** Stock or quiet after-market systems **only.** Riders with loud exhaust will be asked to leave the ride.
11. Approved helmets must be worn.
12. All riders must be at least 21 years of age.
13. Dress appropriately for cold weather.
14. Irresponsible or inconsiderate behavior and riding **will NOT be** tolerated.
15. Stay on the groomed trail surface.
16. Respect your fellow riders and volunteers: Please be **ON-TIME** for departures, meals, re-fueling and arrival each afternoon.
17. Never Surrender Inc wants you to have a positive experience. Ensure your machine has been tuned up and ready for a good ride. In the event you have a breakdown, we will do our best to have a loaner sled for you to use.
18. You must be an experienced rider capable of riding at moderate trail speeds for several hours. We will ride up to 150 miles per day, each of the two days.

A rider may be asked to leave the ride for an infraction of any of the above rules. No fees or expenses will be refunded in such a situation.
